### **Workplace**

The Exploratory Project on International Politics and Conflict Resolution (Fbk-CeRPIC) has been inaugurated in February 2012 with the ambitions of developing and enriching the Italian network of scholars of international politics as well as becoming the main location for the specific study of war and peace in the country, networking with like-minded institutes at the national and international level and thus contributing to develop and propose an Italian point of view on those issues.

### **Position**

The candidate is expected to expand the project's network of young researchers. The successful candidate will spend between 1 and 6 months working at FBK, during which time he or she is expected to complete an ongoing project on issues regarding international politics, international relations, or international theory. In addition to finishing the research project, the visiting fellow will be expected to be an active participant in the growth and development of the center, and to seek collaborative research opportunities with other CeRPIC members.

### **Job requirements**

- PhD in Political Science, International Relations, or a related field
- Currently employed in a junior faculty position within a university
- Oral and written proficiency in English
- Self-motivation and ability to work independently
- Desire and capability to engage in teamwork and collaborative research

Candidates will be evaluated primarily on the quality of the submitted proposal, which must include a detailed description of the project, an assessment of its importance and likely impact, a summary of related tasks already completed, and a timeline for completion of the project.

*Due to FBK's attempt to promote equal opportunity and gender balance, in case of equal applications, female candidates will be given preference.*
