Global Governance on Minority Rights: Assessing the UN Forum on Minority Issues

Dr Corinne Lennox's seminar "Global Governance on Minority Rights: Assessing the UN Forum on Minority Issues" will provide insight into the role of two types of non-state actors (NSAs) in the UN's only global governance institution on minority rights: the UN Forum on Minority Issues (Forum). Dr Lennox will examine how civil society organisations and epistemic communities challenge the normative boundaries set by international human rights standards for governing the rights of minority groups.

She aims to illustrate the nature of participation by civil society organisations and epistemic communities.

Dr. Corinne Lennox is Senior Lecturer in Human Rights and Associate Director of the Human Rights Consortium. Her research interests include the human rights of ethnic, religious and linguistic minorities and indigenous peoples, civil society mobilization and caste-based discrimination.

She has worked for many years as a human rights practitioner with various NGOs, including at Minority Rights Group International, and has been a trainer on human rights-based approaches to development for several international development agencies.
