

Human rights in Nepal Seminar with Bharat Singh Thapa,

Assistant Professor, Tribhuvan University and Apex College, Kathmandu, Nepal Human Rights Centre | University of Padova

The seminar **Human Rights in Nepal** offers an insight into the various human development and human rights projects carried out in Nepal and addresses, in particular, poverty, child education and women's rights. It aims at drawing links between human rights and microfinance programmes, showing how a robust culture of microfinance projects can improve the living conditions of the Nepalese people.

The invited speaker, **Bharat Singh Thapa** is an assistant professor at the Apex College's faculty, in Kathmandu (Nepal), the university that has hosted the winter school "Microfinance in Action" since 2015. He is a faculty member at the Central Department of Management, specialising in Finance, Micro Finance, and Business.

The Winter School is organised every year by the University of Padova Human Rights Centre, which gives students from the MA Human Rights and Multi-level Governance a chance to see how microfinance can be a useful tool in the fight against extreme poverty.
