Travel suggestions

From Bologna airport (preferable option)

From Marconi airport, catch the Aerobus to the Bologna Centrale train station, it departs every 11 minutes (it takes approx. 25 min to arrive, each ticket costs € 6,00).

From the train station, take the train - Regionale Veloce or Intercity - to Senigallia (approx. 2-2.15 hours, each ticket costs from € 14,35 to € 23,50 - hint: the sooner you book the train tickets, the better).


Get off in Senigallia train station and catch the bus to Ostra (the bus company name is Bucci).

The bus stop is just in front of the station. You will be in Ostra in approx. 20 minutes, eacht ticket costs around € 2,20 and you can buy the ticket on board without additional costs.

Important: you need to get off to the bus stop near "Il punto" bar, in Ostra (if you have doubts, ask the driver).

Now, from the bus stop walk toward La Cantinella restauranthotel.

From Rome airports

- A) From Fiumicino Airport,
- take the train Leonardo Express it departs every 15 minutes from Fiumicino Airport to Roma Termini train station (approx. 35 minutes, each ticket costs € 14,00)

OR

- catch the bus transfer to Roma Termini on the bus stop n. 6, outside terminal n. 3 on the right (see the timetable on the following website: http://www.romeairportbus.com, each ticket costs € 8,90).
- B) From Ciampino Airport, catch the bus transfer to Roma Termini train station on the bus stop n. 3, (see the timetable on the following website: http://www.romeairportbus.com, each ticket costs € 8,90)

When in Roma Termini, take the train Regionale Veloce from Roma Termini to Jesi (approx.. 3 hours and 30 minutes, each ticket costs € 15,90).

To check the timetable, see the Italian train company website http://www.trenitalia.com/

When in Jesi, walk towards the bus stop "Portavalle" and catch the bus Crognaletti from Jesi to Ostra (approx. 25 minutes).

Hint: each ticket costs € 2,90 and it is preferable to buy it in a tobacco shop - so called "tabaccheria", ask for a "biglietto Tariffa 5" -. You can also buy it on board but it costs € 1 more.

Important: you need to get off to the bus stop near "Il punto" bar, in Ostra (if you have doubts, ask the driver).

Now walk from the bus stop to La Cantinella restaurant-hotel (see the map above!).
