After earning an M.D. from Michigan State University, he took his surgical subspecialty training in ophthalmology at Harvard University's Medical School. Dr. Hall is an internationally acclaimed award-winning author of several books of poetry. *Nigger For Life* chronicles his painful discovery that in "unspoken America" race is the yardstick by which he is first judged, first measured, and diminished value and dignity metered out. *Winter's A' Coming Still* reflects the pernicious persistence of race as a primary social frame. The more things are said to change, the more things are made to stay the same. *Appalling Silence*, with selections of his work translated into Telugu and Urdu, was published in India.
