Weaponizing water: Forced evictions and ecocide in the Iraqi Marshlands

The Marsh Arabs (al Ma'dān) are an indigenous group who lived for millennia in Iraq's southern Mesopotamian wetlands, building reed houses (mudhif), herding water buffalo, and developing a unique ecological culture tied inseparably to the marsh environment.

After the 1991 Shi'a uprising against Saddam Hussein's regime, the Marsh Arabs were collectively punished. Beginning in 1991, gigantic drainage projects deliberately destroyed their wetlands.

The Mesopotamian marshes of southern Iraq—long a distinctive ecological, cultural, and economic landscape—were systematically transformed in the late twentieth century through policies of large-scale water diversion, drainage, and targeted repression. What might at first appear as a technical project of irrigation and land reclamation is better understood as a deliberate strategy of social control and counterinsurgency with profound environmental and human consequences. Drawing on archival documents, remote-sensing and ecological science, contemporary reporting, NGO and UN assessments, and historical scholarship, this essay traces the causes and consequences of marsh destruction, evaluates competing explanations (technical versus intentional political violence), assesses ecological and human recovery efforts since 2003, and outlines legal and policy pathways for accountability and durable restoration.

A video by Hakan Tosun, the human rights activist and independent journalist, who was terribly beaten to death just before ZEM on the 10th of October.

Constructing legitimacy from the 2023 February Earthquakes impacting 11 cities in the Eastern and South Eastern Turkey, the AKP government did not miss the opportunity to intervene in the relevant cities via land grabs and forced evictions by means of unjust urban transformation laws enacted right after the earthquakes. The video documents the land grabs in the city of Hatay's Samandag region where the most pluralist society comprising Muslims, Christians and Arab Alevis have lived in harmony for centuries. The intervention while opening new accumulation outlets for pro-government capital, especially for construction companies, concurrently aims to disrupt the plural society and Islamize the region by triggering displacement and forced evictions of the community.

Negli USA, alcuni giudici hanno contestato questi algoritmi, mentre stati come New York li hanno vietati. L'automazione della giustizia, spesso con orientamento conservatore, complica ulteriormente la tutela dei diritti abitativi. Le conseguenze includono la concentrazione della proprietà, l'aumento della precarietà abitativa e degli sfratti. Questo fenomeno solleva interrogativi sul futuro controllo dell'Intelligenza Artificiale e sul suo impatto sociale.

The results show the discrimination faced by students in the current housing market, which compromises their fundamental housing rights.

Understanding Homelessness in Italy

The issue of homelessness has been the subject of extensive research in Italy and internationally,

with a range of connotations being attributed to the term. It is generally recognised that it is a multifaceted phenomenon associated with numerous aspects of the life of an individual. The discussion should centre on the concept of housing as a human right, rather than as a form of reward

for good behaviour. Therefore, the implementation of a national strategy is essential for addressing this issue, which must be conceptualised as a “public problem”. Moreover, the social concept of “home” and the cultural concept of “housing” are examined as factors influencing healthcare, social

integration and the majority of factors of personal and communitarian welfare. The following discussion will explore the concept of a mixed welfare system, such as the Italian one, which includes family, labour market and Third Sector components, in relation to the phenomenon of homelessness. The issue of a “new homelessness” is intricately linked to the ongoing citizenship crisis, with the loss of personal and social identity formation being a key concern. The absence of a unified set of needs expressed by people experiencing homelessness further complicates the policy discourse surrounding them. In this discussion, the evolution of the aforementioned debate will be analysed, along with the landscape of the phenomenon in Italy and its local specificity.

It also seeks to denounce threats and violence of all kinds suffered by the defenders of these rights.

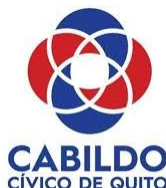
